

NQACC PESTICIDE POLICY SUMMARY

North Queen Anne Child Care does not regularly apply any pesticides to our facility/building. If it is necessary to apply pesticides we will use the Environmental Protection Agency guide to Integrated Pest Management. This manual can be found at www.epa.gov/pesticides/ipm/#bkmrk1 .

Parents and employees of NQACC will be notified by e-mail and postings around the center in the event a pesticide application is necessary. Notification will happen at least forty-eight (48) hours before a building/structural/landscape pesticide application.

Notices will include the following information:

- Product Name
- Date and time of application
- Location where the pesticide will be applied
- Pest to be controlled
- Contact name and phone number

A record of any pesticide application will be kept in the child care office for 7 years.

We shall provide written notification annually to parents. A copy of the policy is available in the director's office and is available by request from the director.

We do not store pesticides in the child care building or on the grounds. We will contact Washington Pest Consultants Association for proper disposal recommendations of empty pesticide containers. <http://pep.wsu.edu/waste/wapca.html>
